



## WiseUp PERSONAL ALARM

Your Personal Alarm is fitted with a high-intensity strobe bulb that produces a flashing light when the 130 decibel alarm is activated

(by pulling the rip-cord/panic pin). Your Personal Alarm has the added advantage of an independent light source, when the side button is pressed.

### **To Operate**

To operate your Personal Alarm in a panic situation, simply pull the ripcord out of its socket. To stop the alarm (and flashing light), replace the ripcord pin into the socket on top of the unit.

### **Several Uses**

There are several ways to use your Personal Alarm.

- Carried by yourself (quickly accessible in an outer pocket)
- Clipped to your waistband (waist-clip on back of unit), with ripcord accessible or attached to wrist.
- The waist-clip may also be removed (it is very firm but it does slide down and out of holding track). The waist-clip can now be used as a bracket to be screwed onto the inside wall near your homes door. This bracket will allow you to situate the alarm on a wall for your convenient placement when leaving and returning to your home. In this convenient location, the Personal Alarm will also provide you with a means of protection when answering your door.

### **Personal Alarm Tips**

#### **General Use**

- Always carry the Personal Alarm ready for use.
- Tell someone where you are going.
- If possible, tell someone what time you expect to return.
- Be alert and aware of your surroundings.

#### **When in Vehicle**

- Always have your Personal Alarm ready for use.
- Always park in well-lit areas
- Have your keys ready as you approach your vehicle.
- If another vehicle is signalling you to stop do not pull over in an isolated spot. If you pull over wait until you reach a public area.
- Be alert at all times.

### **Before you use your Personal Alarm**

- Make sure you know how to activate and de-activate your Personal Alarm.
- Make regular checks on power. At the first indication of weak sound – replace the battery.
- Practice appropriate methods of carrying your Personal Alarm ready for use.

### **Caution**

- The alarm should be kept out of reach of children.
- Test your Personal Alarm regularly outdoors at arms length away from the ear.

### **Battery Installation**

Loosen the two screws on back of alarm with a small screwdriver. Gently part the back from the front of the alarm to access the battery compartment. Attach 9v battery to the connector and place battery into the battery compartment. Re-fit the back cover and tighten screws.
